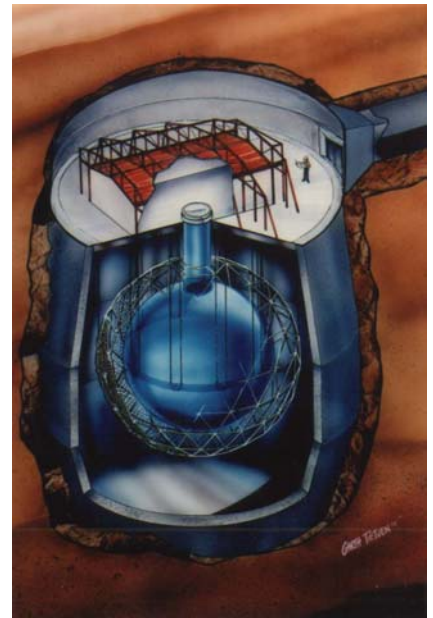
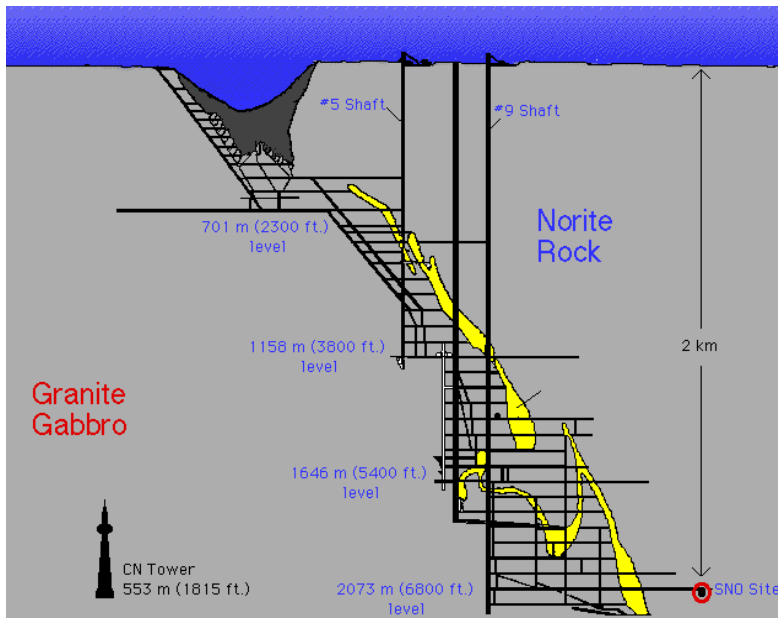


Sudbury Neutrino Observatory Expansion, Sudbury, Ontario

The internationally renowned and widely respected Sudbury Neutrino Observatory (SNO) is expanding to accommodate several large-scale experiments, several medium scale experiments and experiment support and prototyping facilities. The Observatory is located at the 6800 Level of the Creighton mine, near Sudbury, Ontario.



CNA is part of a multidisciplinary team selected to prepare conceptual, preliminary and final designs for remodeling of the existing laboratory facilities, and construction and outfitting of new laboratory caverns. CNA's role is space programming, conceptual design and layout, fire and life safety and peer review.
